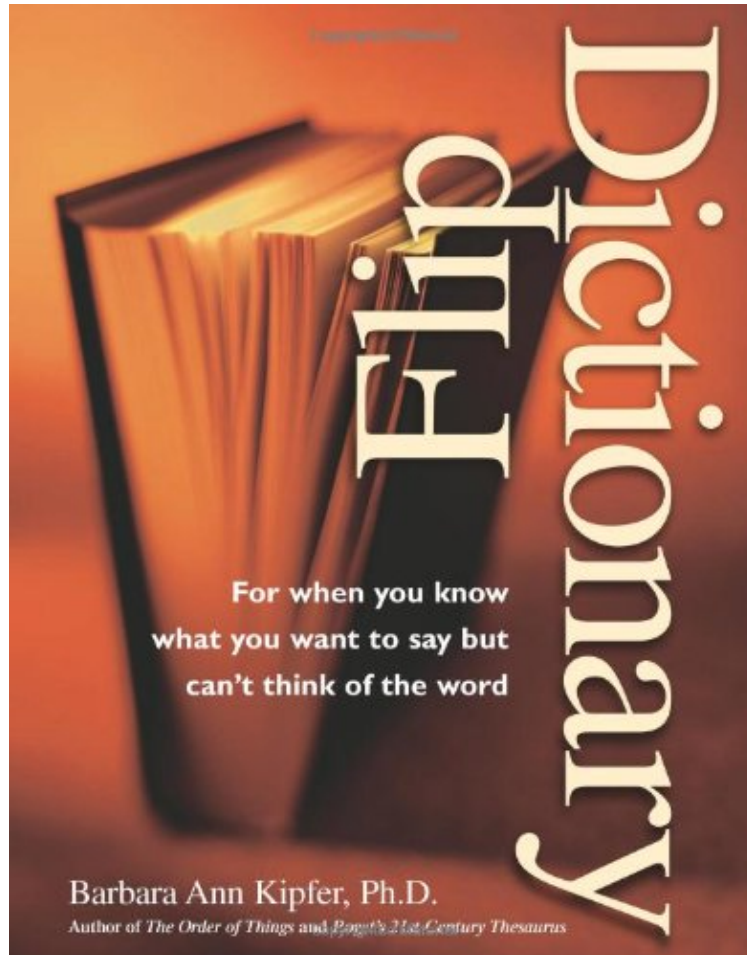

Well, this author, inspired by a stroke of genius no doubt, solves that very irritating problem by sectioning off words into groups (not

like a thesaurus or a dictionary) so you can look up the word with a description or a word you can recall. For instance, if you need a word to describe a ship - simply look up ship/shipping terms and there's a whole list of words that you wish you'd thought of...and among them is the word you were reaching for. Big thanks to the author for writing this one!

You know what you want to say but can't think of the word. You can describe what you're thinking but you don't know the name for it. Flip Dictionary solves this common problem!
