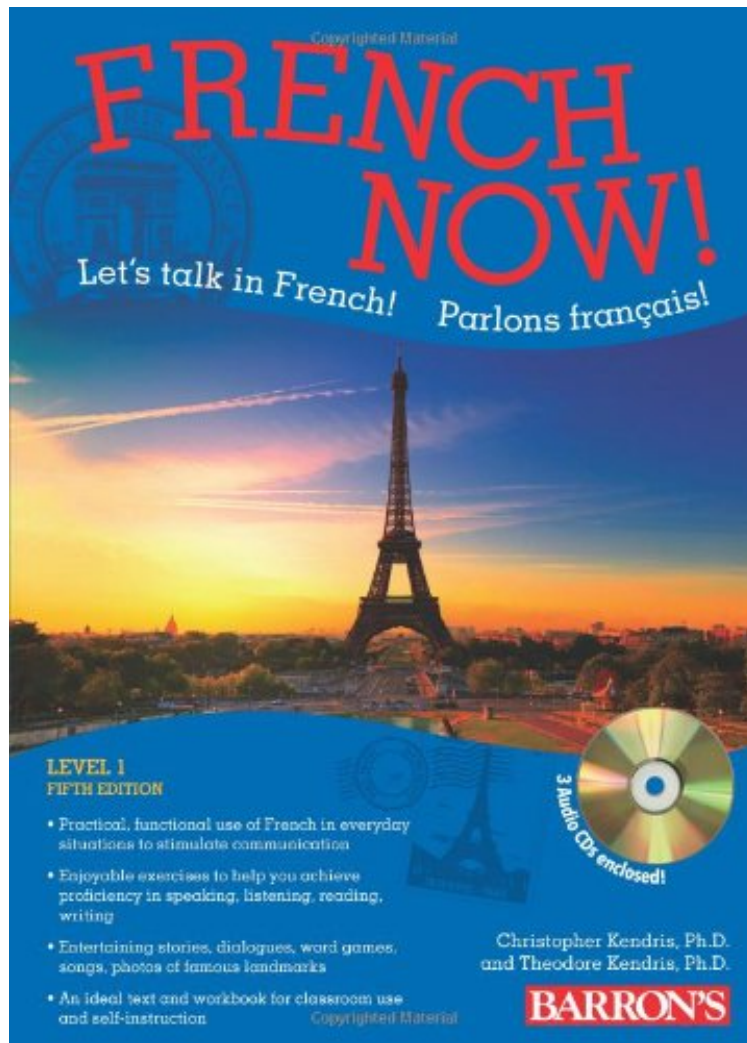

I bought the 3rd edition of this book (French Now! A Level One Worktext) locally (not online), and there were no CDs or answer key in it. This book is pretty much the same as the 3rd edition, but there are 3 CDs and in the back of the book (revised) is the CD transcript and the answer key to all the activities. I would recommend this book.
Note: If the fifth edition had been cheaper, then I would have bought it. Unfortunately, it just came out and there was nothing cheaper than \$18.00. So if the 5th edition is cheaper by now, I would recommend buying it instead, as the most updated version is probably the best bet. Here's the 5th Edition: French Now!
