I have actually ordered several books and NONE of them are color coded!! I am working with kids that are in grades 1-5 and most have no basic music knowledge. Color coding would make this so much easier in the beginning!! This book progresses in difficulty, so you would think at least the lower difficulty pieces would have some color to them. But they don't. I teach a children's choir at my church. So, as I said, I am not a professional by any means. However, I do

have a decent amount of knowledge about basic music theory. I am a singer and have been able to read music for many, many years. I found this book somewhat difficult to understand. It just doesn't seem to flow well. I ended up making a separate poster with color coded notes for a couple of the songs. I could have done that with any basic piece of sheet music from the internet.
