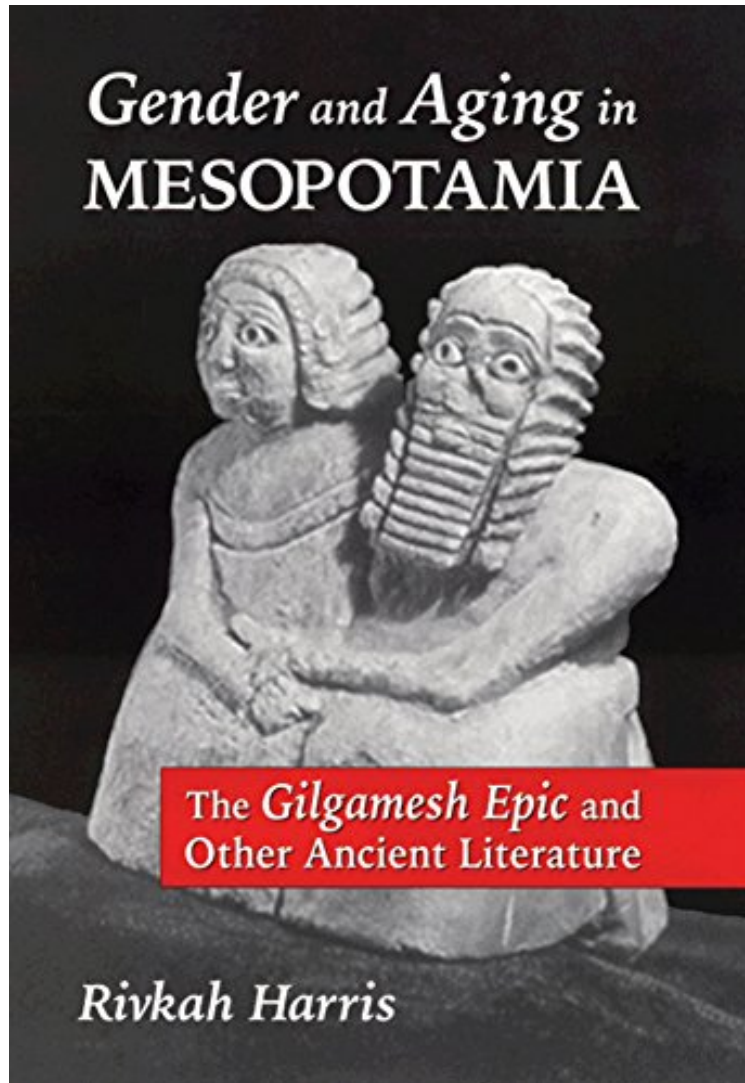


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Gender and Aging in Mesopotamia: The Gilgamesh Epic and Other Ancient Literature
