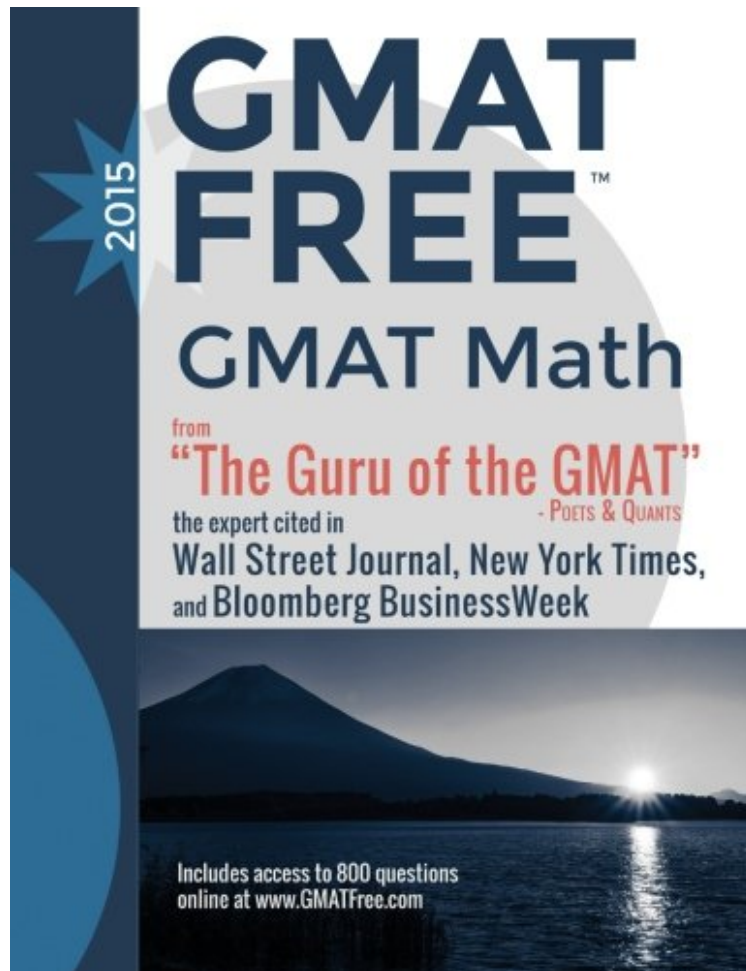

This brief volume covers all mathematical knowledge expected on the GMAT Quantitative section. It covers GMAT arithmetic and algebra, linear and quadratic equations, number properties, population statistics, basic set theory, geometry, and counting methods including permutation and combination. This book focuses on the explanation of mathematical concepts, rather than GMAT practice questions. However, it links to free, realistic GMAT practice questions online -- 800 GMAT practice questions in total.
