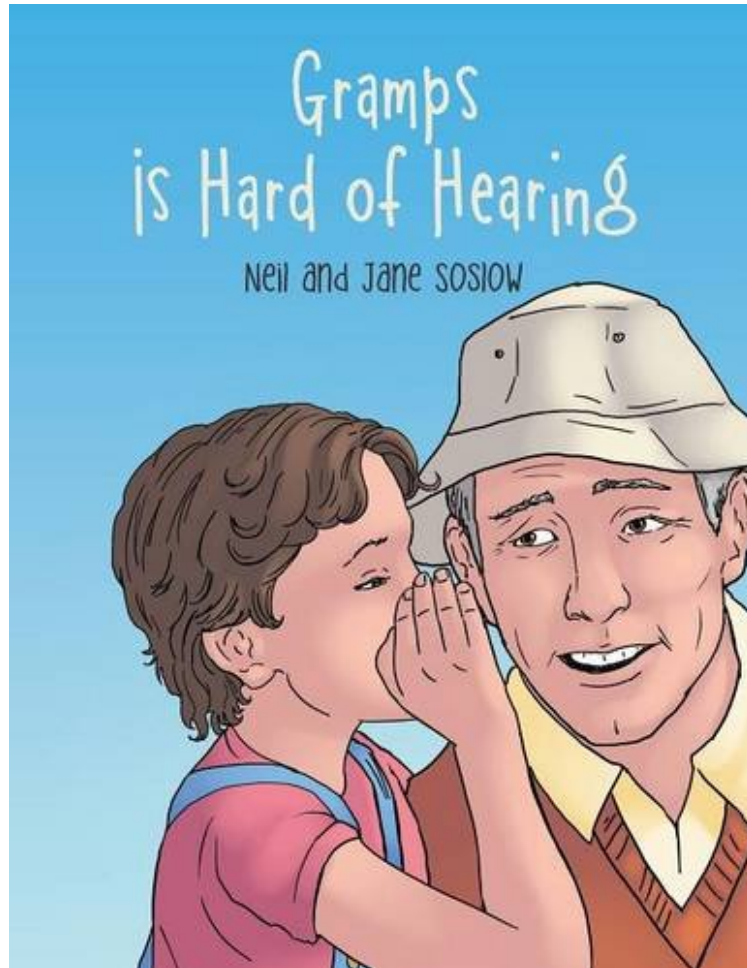

It gives an opening for discussion on recognizing and dealing with family members with hearing loss. Nice illustrations and an easy quick read. A great quick bed time story for any family, especially for any family with young children and hearing impaired family members. A must have!

He keeps thinking she's asking something about the "dark" or other words that rhyme with "park," but he finally gets the gist, and they set out to enjoy the day together. As Caroline spends quality time with her grandfather, she learns all about hearing deficits, including what a hearing aid looks like, how it operates, and why it sometimes squeals when someone gets too close to it or when it's adjusted. Caroline and Gramps even find out they know some basic sign language that they can teach each other. Filled with wonderful illustrations to help children understand concepts, this story celebrates family values and is a must-have for anyone hard of hearing who wants to develop a deeper understanding and a stronger bond with loved ones.
