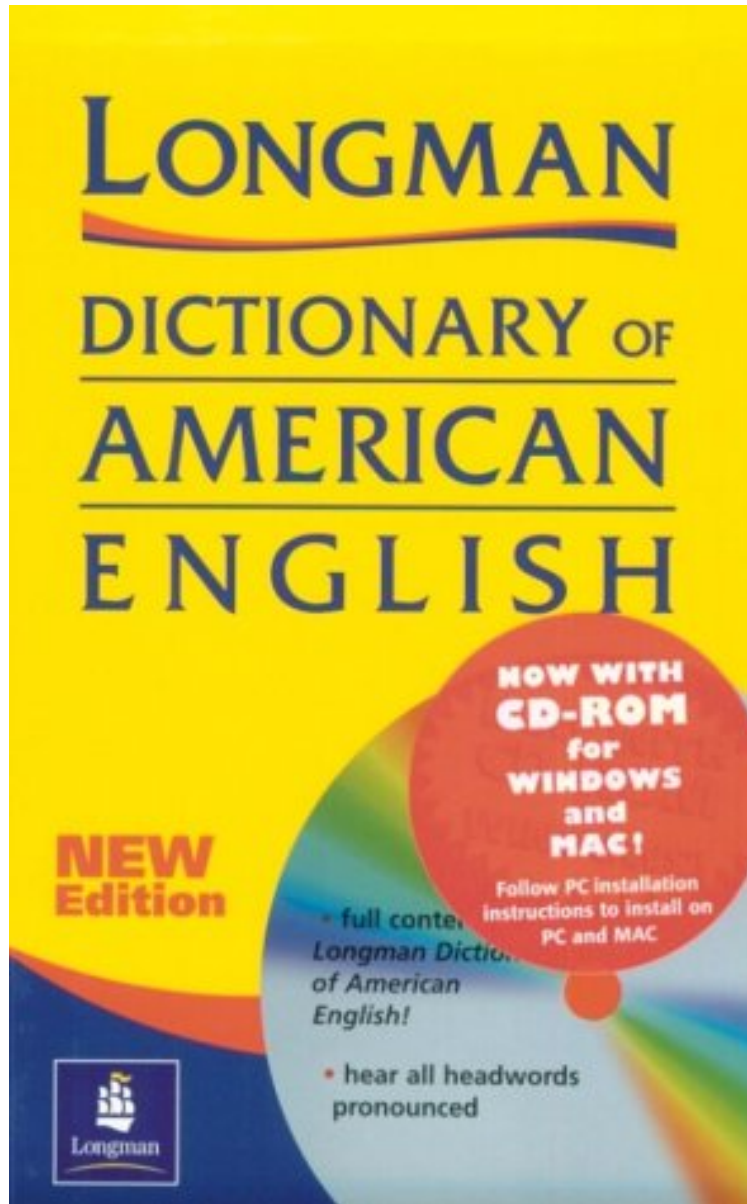

This dictionary is very easy to read, especially for people whom English is a 2nd language, like myself. It uses very simple words to describe the new words. The Thesaurus is right under the word, you can read it with the word without checking another section in the dictionary. It's very convenient and usable. And the program on the CD is so easy to use. It does require you to put the CD in a CD-drive and will check for it. But what's the problem? There are many other much more expensive audio editing programs that's doing similar things. The dictionary contains only 50K words. A little less compared to other dictionary. But this also makes it small and light enough to be portable. I wish I knew and had bought this dictionary when I first came to the States some twenty years ago. Highly recommended, especially for people whom English is their 2nd language. There is an issue with the dictionary. The dictionary does not have enough words for my daily use. Sometime even my third-grader cannot find the words she looked for from her text book. This caused major inconvenience and I'm switching to Oxford.

I have to agree with all of the other reviewers here. After a lot of research, I came to the same conclusion: this is a great book to recommend to ESL learners who are of Intermediate to Advanced level. NOTE: This is a heavy dictionary, not one to carry to and from class every day. Best to keep as a classroom resource or a home reference. It's also the cheapest of the Longman Dictionaries at this level (newer versions are \$50). This 4th edition, with CD-ROM, is from 2008 and is just fine. For \$3 dollars less, you can purchase this book without the CD-ROM (ISBN: 978-0132449809), but that would be a silly choice. Even if a student doesn't have a home computer now (and many of my students do not), he will likely have one in the future. There is also a Basic Dictionary of American English by Longman (ISBN: 978-0132449809) for almost the same price (minus the CD). It is half the size/thickness/weight, but the definitions are too sparse; it doesn't offer enough explanations or examples for students. Still, if your students are really low-level, the "Longman Dictionary of American English, 4th Edition (paperback with CD-ROM)" might be too challenging.
